Pursuant to order dated 25.08.2015, learned State counsel seeks to place on record short reply by way of affidavit of Jatinder Singh, Inspector/SHO, P.S. Dareshi, Ludhiana. Operative para thereof reads as under:-

“That in compliance with orders dated 25/08/2015 passed by this Hon'ble Court, both the parties alongwith respectable person were called on 29.08.2015. Both the parties have entered into compromise. As per the terms of the compromise petitioner Indu Bala will give statement in the trial court or in this Hon'ble Court in favour of Rajesh Kumar for quashing the FIR No.64 dated 18/12/2011, U/s 354/323/341/294 and 506 IPC, P.S. Dareshi, Ludhiana. Similarly respondent Rajesh Kumar will withdraw the complaint pending in the Court of Sh. Bikramdeep Singh Ld. JMJC, Ludhiana against Indu Bala and he will give statement for this purpose in favour of her. So dispute between the

petitioner and respondent no.1 has been amicably settled. True translation copy of compromise enclosed as Annexure R-1/T. This is brought to the notice of this Hon'ble Court in compliance with orders dated 25/08/2015.

In view of the above, no further directions in this petition are necessary. Parties are at liberty to avail remedy available to them in case any cause of action survives.
