Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks direction to the official respondent to hand over the investigation in FIR No.556 dated 4.9.2015 registered under Sections 420, 406 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Jagadhri to some independent agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not intend to press this petition regarding transfer of investigation to some independent agency for the time being, reserving the right of the petitioner to do so at the appropriate stage, when necessity arises. He submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed, he finally approached the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.2 by way of self-contained representation dated 5.10.2015 (Annexure P-2), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide his representation, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner raised in his representation dated 5.10.2015 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Respondent No.2 is further directed to ensure that an effective, fair and impartial enquiry is conducted by the investigating agency, in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
