Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of direction to respondents no.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.3 to 9.

As per office report dated 2.11.2015, notices could not be issued to the respondents, as counsel for the petitioner had not filed the process fee and therefore, vide order dated 3.11.2015, on the undertaking of learned counsel for the petitioner to file the process fee, fresh notices were ordered to be issued for today.

However, neither the process fee has been deposited nor learned counsel for the petitioner is present today.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Kamlesh, submits that the police has visited the houses of respondents no.3 to 9 and have recorded their statement. As per statements of respondents no.3 to 9, they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and they have further stated that there is no threat from their side.

In view of the aforesaid situation, this petition is disposed of, the same having been rendered infructuous.

However, in case there is still any apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they can approach the Superintendent of Police, Mewat - respondent no.2 who shall look into their grievance, if any, in accordance with law.
