By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner No.1 Tej Pal Kaur has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.82, dated 12.09.2014, registered under Sections 328 r/w Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Rampura, District Bathinda.

The learned counsel contends that no role is attributed to the petitioner No.1-Tej Kaur. Even, she was not present in the house at the time of occurrence. She has been falsely implicated in this case.

The learned State counsel, submits that in pursuance of

the order passed by this Court, the petitioner No.1 Tej Kaur has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted to petitioner No.1-Tej Kaur, by this Court vide order dated 30.10.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
