JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Three petitioners/accused are seeking the quashing of FIR No.95 dated 26.05.2012, under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471, IPC, registered with Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural (**Annexure P-1**) and the subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise (**Annexure P-2**), arrived at between the parties. An affidavit dated 07.05.2014 of the complainant-Mehnga Singh, admitting the compromise, has also been annexed as **Annexure P-3**.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 30.10.2014, had permitted the parties to present themselves before the learned Illaqa Magistrate on 11.12.2014 for recording of their statements.

It appears that the statements on the said date could not be recorded, therefore, another request was made and this Court, vide order dated 29.01.2015, permitted the parties to get their statements recorded in terms of the compromise.

As per report received from learned trial Court, no statement has been got recorded uptill today.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, submits that upon investigation and in view of the said compromise, a cancellation report has already been prepared and submitted before the Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, District Amritsar. Therefore, in such circumstances, the grievance of the petitioners, more or less, stands redressed.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
