This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.10 dated 21.02.2015 under Section 22 of Narcotic and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station City-2, Mansa.

Allegedly recovery of 8 vials of rexcof syrup was effected from the petitioner. Quantity is stated to be non-commercial in nature. Petitioner is in custody since 21.02.2015.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that recovery effected from the petitioner is non-commercial in nature, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
