AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.179 dated 27.07.2015, registered under Sections 323, 326, 342, 498-A, 406, 506, 509, 34 IPC, at Police Station Farrukh Nagar, District Gurgaon.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he bit off the first digit of the little finger of his brother-in-law (sala) when he came to the house of the petitioner to intervene in the matrimonial dispute between him and his wife.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner

has now been in custody for more then 2 months.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar has accepted the aforementioned factual assertions.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
