JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Khushdeep Singh in case FIR No.70 dated 20.07.2015 for offence punishable under Section 452, 324, 323, 427, 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 325 IPC added later on) registered with Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

As per allegations Petitioner along with his accused-father Rajbhinder Singh attacked complainant Jagmail Singh. The accused father is alleged to have inflicted a *gandasa* blow on the palm of left hand of complainant whereas Petitioner accused is attributed a *dang* blow on the backside of the complainant. They are also alleged to have inflicted injuries on the intervenor in the fight i.e. Jasdev Singh.

It is contended that main accused Rajbhinder Singh has since been arrested and granted bail whereas the Petitioner has been falsely implicated being son of the main accused. Even otherwise a simple *dang* blow has been attributed on the backside of the complainant.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lakhvir Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 30th of October, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
