The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.63, dated 8.6.2015, registered under Sections 307 of the IPC and Sections 27/54/59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner states that she does not press this petition but states that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court and a direction be issued to the trial Court to decide the bail application of the petitioner within a reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this petition is dismissed as not pressed. The trial Court is directed that in case the

petitioner surrenders within a week and moves an application for regular bail, the same be decided in accordance with law within two days of its filing.
