Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.161 dated 30.10.2012 registered under Sections 22, 61 and 85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was released on regular bail and thereafter he had been regularly appearing on every date of hearing before the learned trial Court. However, on 21.8.2015, petitioner could not put appearance, because of bona fide reasons and circumstances, which were beyond his control. He further submits that petitioner is ready to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week from today and learned trial Court may be directed to consider his bail application at an early date by passing an appropriate order.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, instant petition is disposed of, directing the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court within a period of one week from today. Once the petitioner surrenders, the learned trial Court shall consider his bail application, keeping in view all the relevant facts and circumstances of the case, which shall be brought to its notice, at the instance of the petitioner and thereafter appropriate order shall be passed, strictly in accordance with law but at an early date.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
