Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that compromise has been effected between the parties and the entire amount of Rs.20 lacs has been paid to the complainant by way of three bank drafts dated 25.03.2015. Photocopy of the same is taken on record.

Vide order dated 30.01.2015, petitioner was directed to be released on interim bail in case of depositing a bank draft of Rs.20 lacs in the name of complainant with the trial Court. He is stated to be on interim bail till 31.03.2015.

In view of the fact that another sum of Rs.20,00,000/- has been paid to the complainant today, no purpose would be served putting the petitioner behind bars.

Interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute on filing fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
