Petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Ballo, Aunt (Bua) of the petitioner, alleging that petitioner in connivance with his father Veer Singh had obtained a fake decree by producing three ladies in place of his sisters. The father of the petitioner, on the basis of said fraudulent consent decree had further relinquished the rights in favour of the petitioner and his brother. The petitioner had allegedly executed a forged agreement of sale in favour of

other persons as the Civil Court decree in favour of the father of the petitioner had been challenged.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, State counsel and going through the record, it transpires that the dispute is pertaining to a land which is subject matter of civil litigation. The petitioner appears to have not alienated the property on the basis of the agreement of sale and the right, title and interest of the complainant, till date, has not been affected by the agreement of sale which prima facie does not confer title on the alleged beneficiary. Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. August 25, 2014 and challan has already been presented.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
