Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Manoj Kumar in case FIR No.77 dated 27.09.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420 of Indian Penal Code and Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 registered with Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

Petitioner is a depot holder for selling kerosene oil. Recovery of 2000 liters of kerosene oil has been effected from his possession which is not accounted for in the records.

At the time of hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has since been arrested.

Dismissed as infructuous.
