The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 62 dated 13.07.2014 registered at Police Station MDC, Panchkula (Haryana) under Sections 395/397/384/412/201/120-B IPC and Section 25(54) of Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the only role attributed to the petitioner is that he had purchased the stolen gold from the co-accused which was only 900 gms. The counsel urges that at the most it would be a case under Section 412 IPC and there is no other case pending against the petitioner and the investigation is over.

Learned State counsel submits that this is a case where dacoity took place at Jewellers shop and the role attributed to the petitioner is that he had purchased the stolen goods.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the investigation is over, challan has been filed and the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
