The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.127, dated 18.2.2014, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Jhajjar, Haryana.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is stated to be a witness of the alleged forged Will, the case is of Magisterial trial and that the petitioner has now been in custody for more than one month.

Learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from SI Vijender Pal, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits

of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
