Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.259 dated 15.05.2015 under Sections 20 of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 ('NDPS Act' for short) and Section 29 of NDPS Act (added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

After having been confronted with the fact that petitioner stood convicted in one case of NDPS Act itself, at an earlier point of time and his acquittal in another case under NDPS Act, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition.

Permission is granted.
