Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.242 dated 16.09.2014, under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 31.10.2014:-

“Notice of motion for 18.12.2014.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioners be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. They shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

At this stage, Mr. Nakul Sharma, Advocate appears on behalf of complainant.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Sub Inspector Darshan Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 31.10.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
