This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in Complaint Case No. 24, dated 05.01.2012/27.09.2012 filed under Sections 323, 324, 452, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocity) Act, 1989, pending before the Sub-Division Judicial Magistrate, Derabassi.

This Court vide order dated 31.10.2014 has allowed the interim bail to petitioner No.2, namely, Bimla wife of Janga Singh, who is a household lady whereas interim bail was not granted to petitioner No.1-Janga Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 31.10.2014 passed by this Court, petitioner No.2, namely, Bimla wife of Janga Singh has joined investigation and no more required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 31.10.2014. are made absolute.

However, petitioner No.2 shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
