1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?
2. To be referred to reporters or not?

HARI PAL VERMA, J.(Oral)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no. 4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners being major have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, respondents No.4 to 7 are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they have moved a representation dated 27.10.2015 (Annexure P-5) to respondents No. 2 and 3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana and S.H.O. Police Station, Payal, Tehsil Payal, Distt. Ludhiana respectively.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Madahar, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply requisite set of paper book to learned counsel for the State, during the course of the day.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2, i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana, to take appropriate action, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 27.10.2015 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.
