This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner during the pendency of trial in case FIR No. 165, dated 06.08.2011, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station-Nav Baradari, Jalandhar.

This is second bail application. Earlier bail application was dismissed as withdrawn.

As per allegation of the prosecution, Naib Singh was the owner of some property, whose forged power of attorney was manufactured in favour of Gurminder Singh and Jagjit Singh. The said alleged beneficiary executed power of attorney in favour of Jagroop Singh and Deepak Uppal. It is further alleged that Jagroop Singh and Deepak Uppal executed the sale-deed in favour of Rajinder Kaur and Karjwinder Singh.

The petitioner is stated to be marginal witness of the sale-deed stated to be executed by Jagroop Singh and Deepak Uppal in favour of Rajinder Kaur and Karjwinder Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 23.04.2014 and the petitioner is a lady and the sale-deed is not forged one.

The said factual position has not been disputed by the State counsel. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date.

So, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition stands accepted and the petitioner-Gian Kaur is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
