Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioner who was working as T-mate, had filed the present writ petition claiming promotion as Electrician from the date the persons junior to him were promoted. The petitioner claimed that he was at Sr. No.32 in the seniority list of T-mate, and as the persons at Sr. No.59, 73, 83, 89, 99, 111 and 124 were promoted prior to the petitioner, hence, the petitioner is also entitled for promotion as an Electrician from the same date. As per rules, the petitioner is fully eligible to be promoted to the post of Electrician.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that in view of the judgments of this Court in RSA No.1034 of 1993 titled as Dharam Pal Vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 01.04.2014 and CWP No.10783 of 1997 titled as Chhatar Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 12.03.1998, the case of the petitioner shall be considered for promotion from the date the persons junior to him were promoted. The needful shall be done within a period of four months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the stand taken by the State, the present petition may be disposed of.

Ordered accordingly.
