Prayer in this petition is for quashing of orders Annexure P-5 and P-6.

Order Annexure P-5 related to petitioner No.1 who has since been found innocent, therefore, this petition survives only qua petitioner No.2.

At the very outset, learned counsel for petitioner No.2 submits that petitioner No.2 wants to join main stream, if some interim protection is granted. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Sulakhan Singh states that in case petitioner No.2 appears before the trial Court and join the proceedings, the order declaring him Proclaimed Offender will not be implemented.

In view of the aforesaid statement, let petitioner No.2 appear before the trial Court on 20.04.2015 and file application for regular bail.

In the event of appearance before the trial Court, petitioner No.2 shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court, till decision of application for regular bail on merits.
