Petitioner, by way of instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short "Cr.P.C."), seeks transfer of investigation of the case FIR No. 329 dated 01.12.2014 under Section 304-B IPC, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion was issued and in pursuant thereto replies have been filed.

It is a matter of record that after conclusion of the investigation, police report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction.

In this view of the matter, it goes without saying that

petitioner shall be at liberty to file his protest petition and the same shall be considered by the learned Court in accordance with law.

So far as the prayer of the petitioner for transfer of investigation of the FIR is concerned, the same has been rendered infructuous because investigation is no more pending and the report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented to the Court.

With the above said observations made, present petition stands disposed of.
