Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.187 dated 21.11.2012, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sohana, District Mohali.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 21.12.2012:-

“Notice of motion for 14.2.2013.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners are ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Officer, on compliance of the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and on joining the investigation.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant

Sub Inspector Paramjit Singh has submitted that the

petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 21.12.2012, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
