RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking appropriate directions to the official respondents.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed, they finally approached respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 03.01.2015 (Annexure P-4) but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that petitioners will be satisfied in case Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad-respondent No.4 (wrongly typed as SSP, Fatehabad) is directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners within reasonable time.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the State fairly states that representation of the petitioners shall be considered and decided, in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad-respondent No.4 is directed to look into the matter and consider the grievance raised in their representation dated 03.01.2015 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
