HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.213 dated 2.8.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 326 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are in custody since 10.9.2015. Initially the case under Sections 324 and 326 IPC was not registered against the petitioners. It is only after receiving the medical report, the said offences were added in

the case. Earlier the petitioners were admitted on bail, it is only after additions of Sections 324 and 326 IPC, they were taken into custody.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the nature of injuries attributed to the petitioners does not warrant the relief of regular bail to them.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Bijender Singh submits that the injuries attributed to the petitioners are serious and grave and, therefore, they does not deserve the concession of bail.

Heard.

Taking into consideration the fact that initially the petitioners were already granted bail and it is only on addition of Sections 324 and 326 IPC, they were taken into custody, I deem it appropriate to admit them on bail. The trial in this case will also take long time.

Accordingly, the instant petition for regular bail is hereby accepted. The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
