ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

Two separate petitions have been filed seeking regular bail in FIR No.411 dated 16.07.2015, registered under Section 148, 149, 332, 353, 186, 307, 506 IPC, Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

It had been urged on behalf of both the petitioners that they were arrested on 19.07.2015 and challan has been presented and injury to Constable Amarjit on the head is not attributed to the petitioners.

The police had gone for a raid for recovery of illicit country made liquor. The police party was attacked in which one Constable sustained one injury on the head. Constable Randhir Singh suffered *danda* blows. Constable Amarjit's uniform was torn.

The injury under Section 307 IPC is not attributed to the petitioners. The investigation is over, challan had been presented. The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
