Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.164 dated 17.09.2014, under Sections 498-A, 494 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Line Batala, District Gurdaspur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 03.11.2014:-
