AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent No.4.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record an extract of her Aadhar Card wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 05.09.1992 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record an extract of his Aadhar Card(Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 09.07.1992. They have also requested the police authorities personally for protection of their life and liberty but have not moved any such representation in this context.

In the circumstances, without advertting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to treat this petition as a representation and look into the grievance of the petitioners and take appropriate action in this regard.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
