The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.102 dated 16.09.2013, registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Doraha, Distt. Ludhiana, wherein, the petitioners have been summoned to face trial under Sections 302/34 IPC.

Heard.

On 03.11.2014, a coordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order: -
