Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.234 dated 24.09.2014, under Sections 376, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 03.11.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that respondent No.2 is the wife of the petitioner. However, now parties have amicably settled their dispute.

Notice of motion for 08.01.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant

Sub Inspector Swaran Ram has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 03.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
