AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.283 dated 03.10.2014 registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC at P.S. Sector 17, Chandigarh.

On 22.01.2015 the following order as passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the matter has now been compromised. A sum of Rs.2,00,000/- has been paid and it is agreed that the remaining amount of Rs.50,000/- be paid by way of 10 monthly installments. Learned standing counsel for U.T. Chandigarh states that he has no instructions regarding this compromise and prays for a short adjournment.

Learned standing counsel for U.T. Chandigarh states that he would have no objection if the arrest of the petitioner is stayed in the meantime.

I find this to be a fair request.

Adjourned to 19.02.2015 to enable the UT Administration to verify the settlement made today.

In the meantime, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.”

Today the learned standing counsel for the U.T. Chandigarh on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh has accepted the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In the circumstances, the interim order dated 13.11.2014 is made absolute. However, in case the petitioner does not refund the money as per the compromise, the complainant would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
