The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.),' has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.68 dated 25.09.2015, registered under Sections 306, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Gardhiwal, Distt. Hoshiarpur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is an old lady of about 90 years of age. She was residing separately from the deceased. The petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order passed by this Court on 31.10.2015.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined

the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 31.10.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
