The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 90 dated 12.04.2015 registered at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani under Sections 365 34 IPC.

The allegations contained in the FIR are that the complainant was standing at the Bus Stand waiting for a bus to go from Nakkipur to Jhunjhunu. Vikas of village Rampura came in a vehicle. There were some more persons in the car. The vehicle was stopped and lift was offered to the girl. The allegations were that she was taken to different places and she was given an intoxicating substance and she fell unconscious and was asked to deboard and was taken in another car and finally left at village Chandwas. The allegations were made that she was beaten up when she raised noise. She managed to come out from the car with great difficulty later in the evening.

Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that petitioner was arrested on 02.09.2015 and he has not been named in the FIR.

He further urges that charge has been framed and statement of the complainant has been recorded and out of 7 witnesses 5 witnesses have been examined.

Learned State counsel was asked whether any medical examination of girl was carried out. MLR has been produced. There is no injury. There is a reference of forcible injection by the victim. The report of the chemical examiner is also appended in the police record. FSL report shows that there was no semen on the swabs nor any drug was found in the test carried out on the girl.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
