SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.131 dated 21.10.2012, under Sections 325, 324, 341, 427, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Phagwara and order dated 26.03.2015 whereby petitioner was declared proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had left for United Arab Emirates before the registration of FIR. Co-accused of the petitioner who had faced the trial has since been acquitted by the trial Court. However, petitioner is ready to face the trial.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case, petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within one month from today, he be released on bail, subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
