Ajay Tewari, J (Oral)

This is a petition for protection on the averments that the petitioners got married against the wishes of their parents and apprehend danger to their lives.

Counsel for the petitioners states that after this petition was filed, petitioner No.1 (girl) has been forcibly abducted by respondents No.5 to 8 along with some other persons, and petitioner No.2 will now seek appropriate remedy against that but in the meantime, he also apprehends danger from respondents No.5 to 8 and, therefore, his prayer should be allowed.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from HC Hardip Singh, has accepted that the petitioners have got married, and states that respondent No.5 had appeared before the police on 2.11.2015 and had rather made a statement that he was aware that petitioner No.1 had married petitioner No.2 and he had no objection to the same.

In these circumstances, the plea of petitioner No.2 that he got married petitioner No.1 has been prima facie established. As regards the apprehension of danger by petitioner No.2, it is stated that in this regard he has moved a representation before the SSP Rural Jalandhar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural Jalandhar (respondent No.2) to take an appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).
