This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.10 dated 27.01.2014 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar on the basis of compromise.

The petitioners had allegedly received a sum of Rs.5 lacs on the pretext of sending complainant-Raj Kumar to England.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statement recorded regarding the matter having been compromised voluntarily. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the parties have amicably compromised the matter without any threat, coercion or inducement.

In view of the judgment in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052***, the petition is

allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the petitioners depositing a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Mediation and Conciliation Centre of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh within a period of one month.
