Petitioners have been summoned as additional accused by the trial Court under Section 193 Cr.P.C to face trial in a case under Section 406, 498-A IPC registered at the instance of Makhan Singh, the father of the aggrieved lady Karamjit Kaur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been granted pre-arrest bail.

Learned counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose the application inter alia on the ground that the trial is at final stage and only one witness remains to be examined.

Taking into consideration the stage of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to devolve on the merits. It will be expedient in the interest

of justice, to dispose of this petition with a direction that in case the ladies Jarnail Kaur and Veerpal Kaur file an application for exemption from personal appearance, the same would be allowed, taking into consideration, the other circumstances and stage of the case subject to any conditions imposed.
