For having been found in possession of poppy husk, which is marginally higher than the commercial quantity, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 16.09.2013.

Out of total 5 witnesses, only 2 witnesses have been examined.

Taking into consideration the period of detention suffered by the petitioner in context to the poppy husk recovered, the petition is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to a condition that he will not commit any similar offence during pendency of the trial. In case of any such eventuality, the bail order will be liable to be cancelled.
