Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks directions against the respondent authorities to present the challan in a case arising out of FIR No.118 dated 11.12.2013 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Hathur, Tehsil Jagraon, District Ludhiana.
