AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.238 dated 19.06.2015 registered under Sections 148/149/323/325/285/506 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 Arms Act at Police Station Pataudi, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that it is a case of version and cross version and while two persons from the side of petitioner

were arrested and granted regular bail none from the other side has been arrested and she has instructions to state that the persons from the other side have been granted ad-interim bail and the petitioner's side will not oppose the grant of anticipatory bail to them.

Learned counsel for the complainant and learned Assistant Advocate General have accepted the factual statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner but has argued that the petitioner is the main accused.

Be that as it may, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
