Report dated 16.8.2014 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib has been received after recording statements of accused Harmanjeet Kaur, Gurinder Singh Gulwani, Surinder Kaur and Maninderjit Singh as well as complainant Satinder Singh Angpal and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that it is a pure matrimonial dispute and compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences and for betterment of their future life and there are chances of their re-marriage and in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh vs State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 102 dated 28.5.2013 registered

at Police Station Muktsar City, District Muktsar under sections 420, 313, 506, 34, 120-B, 312 and 315 IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed qua the present petitioners.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
