FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.73 dated 11.04.2013 under Sections 392,120-B IPC registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

The allegations against the petitioner-Jagjit Singh @ Jagga are that he was having common business with complainant Harjinder Singh and out of the dispute between them over money the petitioner is alleged to have taken away money from the car of the complainant while the complainant accused were going together in the car. It is contended on behalf of the petitioners that the parties have effected a compromise which is fairly conceded at bar by learned State counsel on the instructions of HC Rajpal. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that the petitioners are in custody since three months.

In view thereof and keeping in view that being a pure business dispute and that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and that no purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioners be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
