At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of amendment in the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 vide 'The Negotiable Instruments (Amendment) Ordinance, 2015' the instant petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for petitioner further submits that when notice of motion was issued by this Court on 4.2.2015 it was observed that the expiry of period of 30 days in presenting the complaint to the court where case is transferred would be subject to the decision of instant petition.

Keeping in view the above observations, the petitioner shall avail of the appropriate remedy in accordance with law as the complaint was

already returned to him.
