JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 366, dated 26.09.2014 (**Annexure P-1**) for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 202, 34 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 25 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Gannaur, District Sonapat.

As per allegations surfaced in the investigation, which is based on circumstantial evidence, the petitioner is the main accused, who is alleged to have inflicted *knife* blow on the deceased-Surjeet @ Bhola.

After arguing at considerable length and having failed to convince this Court on merits, learned counsel for the petitioner lastly prays for issuing direction to the prosecution to conclude the evidence at the earliest.

Learned State Counsel, on instruction from SI Mohinder Singh, states that only six prosecution witnesses remained to be examined and out of them five have been summoned for 19.11.2015.

The present petition is dismissed.

However, the prosecution is directed to conclude their evidence at the earliest.
