Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.16, dated 09.01.2015, for offence under Sections 304-B/34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Samalkha, Distt. Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the complainant has not supported the prosecution version.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI- Krishan Kumar, submits that the trial is at fag end of conclusion. Moreover, the case is now fixed before the trial Court for prosecution evidence on 18.11.2015 and the only witness i.e. the doctor is required to be examined.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within 03 months from today. In case trial is not concluded within the stipulated period, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek concession of regular bail.

It is, however, made clear that the petitioner would not create any hinderance in the smooth conclusion of the trial.
