This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing the official respondents for taking cognizance of the offence as reported to respondents No.2 and 3 with respect to missing of petitioners' son of aged about 16 years after he was forcibly married to Simran Kaur daughter of respondents No.4 and 5 qua which immediate information was given by brother of the petitioner No.1 to the concerned police authorities, which was registered vide 4305/PC dated 12.10.2015 (Annexure P-1), on which no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G.,

Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, District Fazilka is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 21.10.2015 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law.
