SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.109 dated 02.10.2014, under Sections 295-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 67 of the Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

Following order was passed by this Court on 10.11.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that FIR has also been registered against the complainant.

List again on 13.01.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Labh Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 10.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
