Pursuant to the order dated 20.11.2014, passed by this Court, the report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala, received. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala, has reported that both the parties have entered into a compromise, which is without any pressure, undue influence or coercion.

A perusal of FIR in question shows that it was a matrimonial dispute. Since the husband and wife have amicably settled the dispute, therefore, FIR No. 157 dated 23.5.2011, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala, alongwith consequential proceedings stand quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
