Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.43 dated 28.05.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 05.11.2014:-

“Notice of motion for 12.01.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Bikker Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the

petitioner vide order dated 05.11.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
